

Teachers use ICT enabled tools for effective teaching-learning process

The faculty members use ICT enabled tools for effective teaching-learning process. Efforts are taken by the institute to provide e-learning atmosphere in the classroom. The faculty members effectively incorporate IT enabled learning tools. Library also provides a wide range of e-resources such as e-Journals, e-books, e-contents etc. Our faculty also encourage students to access You Tube videos that help students to improve their communication skills and enhance quality of learning. The major emphasis is on classroom interaction in terms of presentations, seminars, group discussions, quiz/test and laboratory work. Computer laboratory, Language laboratory, Commerce laboratory and VLC with internet have been provided to promote independent learning. Internet and Wi-Fi facility is made available to the students free of cost. The following ICT enabled tools are used by the faculty:

1. Faculty members are encouraged to use power-point presentation in their teaching by using LCD's and projectors.
2. Seminar and VLC Halls are digitally equipped. They are used for organising online seminar/workshop/conference.
3. Online internal exams, quiz are conducted through Google Forms.
4. Online classes through Zoom/ Google Meet applications.
5. Two Smart Boards- One smart board is installed in English Language Laboratory and another in VLC Hall. The Smart Board allows teachers to work through a lesson and save it for students to review at home. Students can watch lessons at home, then come into class to work on their problems with a teacher
