POLICY ON SCHOLARSHIPS AND FREESHIPS

Policy on Scholarships and Freeships

Introduction:

The college is committed to support students from diverse backgrounds through various scholarship and freeship programs. It offers a range of government and non-government scholarships, along with financial assistance from the Satral College Student Help Group. These initiatives are designed to ensure that financial constraints do not hinder deserving students from accessing quality education. Our policy on scholarships and freeships aims to provide equitable opportunities for all students, fostering an inclusive and supportive academic environment.

1. Government Concessions and Other Scholarships

Students admitted to the college and eligible as per government regulations can avail of the following financial concessions and scholarships.

The following rules must be adhered to:

a) A student is allowed to avail of only one scholarship at a time.

b) Students must be aware of all details and conditions related to concessions and scholarships.

c) At the time of admission, students and parents must ensure eligibility for any financial concessions or scholarships.

d) For government scholarships, students must fill out the online form themselves and submit a hard copy to the college on time.

e) Regarding concessions, students must meet the conditions, deadlines, and required documentation, and promptly contact the relevant authorities.

f) Scholarship/financial concession applications must be submitted in person to the office, and a receipt must be obtained. No complaints will be entertained without proof of receipt.

2. Scholarships for Backward Class Students

Students from classified Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC), Denotified Tribes (DT), and Nomadic Tribes (NT) are eligible for central and state government scholarships and concessions. Failed students receive only tuition fees without a maintenance allowance. Two children from a family are eligible for this benefit, but if the third child is a girl, she is also eligible for the scholarship. For SC/ST students, full fees and a

full maintenance allowance are provided if the parents' income is below Rs. 300000. For DT/NT/OBC/SBC students, parents' income must be below Rs. 100000 to receive the full maintenance allowance, and only the tuition fee if below Rs. 100,000. Students must fill out the college form in the prescribed format for these scholarships.

Note: Backward class students should not fill out forms for EBC/Declaration/PTW/STW, etc. concessions.

Timely completion of the scholarship application is necessary for financial aid. The college is not responsible for any financial losses due to delays in application submission.

- 1. **Poor Boy's Fund Scheme**: Inspired by Padma Bhushan Hon. Dr. Babasaheb Vikhe Patil, the college has initiated the Poor Boy's Fund Scheme. This fund is raised with the support of the college and local residents to aid students not receiving any scholarships.
- 2. Attendance Requirement: Students must maintain an 80% attendance rate for scholarship approval. Otherwise, they will have to pay the full college fee.

3. Scholarship for Children of Primary School Teachers

To avail of government concessions, children of primary school teachers must pass their annual exams.

Note: This concession is not available for children of retired teachers.

4. Scholarship for Children of Freedom Fighters

To qualify for the scholarship and financial aid, parents' annual income must be below Rs 3,600. Approved scholarships include a monthly allowance of Rs 20 in addition to the tuition fee.

5. Scholarship for Children of Beedi Workers

To qualify for the scholarship, the annual income of the parents must be below $\gtrless4,800$. There is no grade requirement for this scholarship. Parents must provide a certificate of employment from the *beedi* factory.

6. National Merit Scholarship

Students who secure at least 80% in the 12th-grade exam can apply for this scholarship. Applications are sent to the college by the HSC Board and must be submitted to the college with complete documentation.

7. State Government Merit Scholarship

Students who secure over 80% in the 12th-grade exam can apply. There is no parental income requirement for this scholarship.

8. Scholarship for Differently Abled Students

Differently abled students can apply if they have scored more than 40% in the previous examination. Parental income must be below Rs 24,000. A certificate of disability over 40% from a district surgeon must be submitted.

9. Hindi Scholarship

Students who secure 60% in the 12th-grade exam can apply, provided their parents' annual income is below Rs 25,000. The recipient must study Hindi until the final year of their BA. This scholarship is awarded only to non-Hindi speaking students by the central government.

10. Eklavya Scholarship

First-year M.Com./M.Sc. students can apply if their annual income is below Rs 35,000. Commerce students need a minimum of 60%, and science students need a minimum of 70%. For renewal, students must have 75% attendance and 50% marks in the annual exam. Second-year M.Com./M.Sc. students are not eligible.

11. Maulana Azad Scholarship

Female students from minority communities (Sikh, Parsi, Jain, Buddhist, Christian, and Muslim) with more than 55% marks can apply.

12. Kranti Jyoti Savitrimata Phule Scholarship

This scholarship is for female students.

13. Minority Scholarship

Minority students (Sikh, Parsi, Jain, Buddhist, Christian, and Muslim) with over 50% marks are eligible for the central government post-matric scholarship.

14. Scholarship for Excellence in Physics and Mathematics

Students who secure 60% in the 12th-grade exam, with at least 70% in Physics and Mathematics, can apply.

15. Scholarship Deadlines

The final date for submitting government scholarship applications is August 31st.

Note: Scholarship and concession notices are posted on the notice board. Students must adhere to deadlines. The college is not responsible for losses due to late submission.

16. EBC Concession

Students whose parents' annual income is below Rs. 600,000 are eligible. Living parents must provide an income certificate. In the case of deceased parents, a death certificate must be attached. If both parents are deceased, close relatives can be guardians. The college is not responsible for the rejection of concessions due to false or incomplete information.
